As a group we're proud of the great work done to date. We have helped support people struggling with homelessness, aided disaster recovery efforts, renovated buildings for those in need, restored important green spaces, assisted children with special needs and mentored students and young adults.



Springboard

Springboard is Lendlease Foundation's flagship program focused on sustainability. The program focuses on how living in balance with ourselves, our workplace and our natural environment can not only benefit our wellbeing but also create a network of like-minded people around the globe who are committed to effecting change.

Springboard is Lendlease Foundation's global employee program that is designed to invest in the wellbeing of people, planet and community.

The program incorporates an innovative five-day residential component in Yeppoon on the Capricorn Coast Queensland that gives employees from around the world the opportunity to engage with the Great Barrier Reef Foundation (GBRF), local Indigenous communities and partner with the local community on projects designed to make a difference that is both aspirational and leaves a tangible legacy.

Springboard's origins date back to the early 1990's, prior to the current location Springboard was held on the Tasman Peninsula in Tasmania between 2014 and 2018.

Great Barrier Reef Foundation



Our 10-year partnership with GBRF will support their Reef Islands Initiative (RII). The RII delivers collaborative programs on the ground and in the water to protect and restore critical high-value island habitats across the Reef.

Over the course of the partnership, GBRF will work across 5 distinct islands within the Great Barrier Reef ecosystem with the support of not only Lendlease, but the Australian Government's Reef Trust, the Queensland Government and the Fitzgerald Family Foundation. The Reef Islands Initiative is the largest reef habitat rehabilitation project in the Southern Hemisphere. Springboard relocated to the Capricorn Coast in June 2019 and is a hands-on contribution of employee energy and expertise supporting the community reaffirming Lendlease's commitment to this partnership.
