The Americas Region of Lendlease Celebrates Annual Global Community Day



(New York, NY, September 15, 2016) - Lendlease Community Day, held globally each year, is an opportunity for Lendlease employees to work alongside their colleagues, community partners, and suppliers on a project within the communities in which Lendlease operates.

As one of Lendlease's most popular programs amongst employees, with over 5,000 people from around the world taking part on more than 350 projects each year, Lendlease has helped support people struggling with homelessness, aided disaster recovery efforts, renovated buildings for those in need, restored important green spaces and assisted children with special needs.

"We believe that it's our responsibility to deliver environmental, social and economic value wherever we operate," said Denis Hickey, Chief Executive Officer Americas. "Community Day's purpose is for Lendlease to establish lasting partnerships with the local communities where we have a presence," said Hickey.

In the Americas, over 500 Lendlease employees participated in over 50 projects that included building, gardening, cleaning and painting facilities and organizations that benefit children, families, animals and veterans. Some of Lendlease's notable sponsored Community Day events are listed below:

New York - Lendlease volunteers hosted four separate volunteer events at Henry Street Settlement. Founded in 1893 Henry Street Settlement is one of New York City's oldest not for profit organizations. Henry Street Settlement delivers a wide range of social service, arts and healthcare programs to more than 60,000 New Yorkers each year. Volunteers held a

career fair with students and clients of Henry Street Settlement to generate interest in construction, development and facilities-based careers. In addition, volunteers refurbished the community garden, painted walls in preparation of creating mural in the spring of 2017 and painted offices throughout the center.

Chicago – Lendlease and Related Midwest hosted its 13th Annual Golf Outing, to date the outing has raised more than \$1.6 million for various children’s charities in the Chicagoland area. This year proceeds will be donated to SOS Children’s Villages Illinois, Saturday Place and The Children’s Heart Foundation. The event included participants from the real estate and construction industries with over 300 participants.

Washington DC - Volunteers worked with the Capital Area Food Bank, the largest organization in the Washington metro area working to solve hunger and its companion problems: chronic undernutrition, heart disease, and obesity. By partnering with 444 community organizations in DC, MD, and VA, as well as delivering food directly into hard to reach areas, the CAFB is helping 540,000 people each year get access to good, healthy food. Volunteers were responsible for packing and sorting donated food, and packing bags of food for senior citizens and children.

San Francisco –Volunteers spent the day at Curry Senior Center of San Francisco, the center has been a leader and a lifeline to seniors for more than 40 years. Right in their own neighborhood, seniors can easily access a wide range of essential services through Curry, from healthcare to housing and everything in between. Volunteers prepared and provided lunch to seniors in the dining room and spent time getting to meet the seniors.

Los Angeles – Lendlease staff volunteered at Farm Sanctuary Shelter, founded in 1986 to combat the abuses of factory farming and encourage a new awareness and understanding about farm animals. Today, Farm Sanctuary is the nation’s largest and most effective farm animal rescue and protection organization a non for profit organization focused on animals’ wellbeing. The volunteers spent day painting and fixing fencing around the sanctuary.

Boston – For the second year in the row, Lendlease volunteers visited the East Boston Salesian Boys & Girls Club, volunteers spent the day with installing new sections of turf for their athletic field. The Salesian Boys & Girls Club has been operating in East Boston since 1945. During the school year, its after school program is a home to almost 1000 children in the East Boston neighborhood.

Nashville – Lendlease partnered with Tucker’s House, a non-profit organization that works with families of children with disabilities by



providing home renovation and retrofitting services and resources necessary to make their homes safe and more accessible with no financial burden to the family. Tucker's House selected three families to receive volunteer services from Lendlease's skilled volunteers, the services provided to the three families range from framing to landscaping and even bathroom demolition.

Soaring Height – Davis/Monthan – Lendlease volunteered with Habitat of Humanity Tucson Chapter, volunteers spent the day building a home for one deserving family. Lendlease efforts helped the Tucson Chapter of Habitat of Humanity in working towards meeting their goal of creating 20 new homes for working class families this year.

Since Community Day commenced in 1996, Lendlease employees have volunteered well over 600,000 hours or the equivalent of 68 years' worth of help.
