Lendlease Awarded Four ENR Best Projects Awards

(New York, NY, July 25, 2017) Lendlease, one of the world's largest development, property, infrastructure and construction management firms, is pleased to announce that it has been awarded four ENR New York Best Projects Awards.

Listed below are full descriptions of the ENR Awards and project descriptions:

- **Best Higher Education/Research Project: Columbia University's Manhattanville in West Harlem Development Jerome L. Greene Science Center** - Lendlease served as the Construction Manager for the Jerome L. Greene Science Center (Center) the first building to become operational at Columbia University Manhattanville Campus. The research that will take place in the Center will have implications for the treatment of brain illness – probing the root causes of neurodegenerative diseases, such as Parkinson's and Alzheimer's, and motor neuron diseases, among others.
- **Best Cultural / Worship: Columbia University's Manhattanville in West Harlem Development Lenfest Center for the Arts** - Is the second building to open on the new campus. It is an arts venue designed for the presentation and creation of art across disciplines, providing a dynamic new space for Columbia University School of the Arts and a more publicly accessible home for The Miriam and Ira D. Wallach Art Gallery. Lendlease was responsible for managing the construction of the Lenfest Center for the Arts.
- **Best Residential/Hospitality: 56 Leonard Street** – Lendlease served as the Construction Manager for the luxury residential building largely defined by atypical floor plates and cantilevered floors, as well as the irregular spacing and location of the balconies throughout its 57-stories. Rising 836-feet, each of the luxury condominium building's 146 units has its own private outdoor space outfitted with travertine pavers, a glass railing and a custom designed handrail.
- **Award of Merit Residential/Hospitality: 432 Park Avenue** - At 1,396 feet tall, the structure is the tallest residential building in the Western Hemisphere. The 96-story residential tower consists of 106 ultra-luxurious condominiums. Lendlease managed the construction of 432 Park Avenue.
