

Centre for Children's Health Research wins Queensland award

Brisbane, 31 October 2016: The new Centre for Children's Health Research (CCHR) received top honours at the 2016 Master Builder's Queensland Awards in the Health Facilities over \$5 million category.

Recognised as a stand out among other Queensland finalists, CCHR was acknowledged for its excellence in the building and construction industry with judges focusing their decision on the degree of difficulty and quality of the finished product.

The 2016 Master Builder's Queensland Award winners were announced at the Awards Gala dinner, held at the Royal International Convention Centre, Brisbane on Friday 14 October.

Queensland Health partnered with Lendlease to deliver the vision to create an international centre of excellence to set new standards in paediatric care in Queensland and around the world. Lendlease was responsible for the construction, facade design and internal fit out.
