### Water Play Wonderland at Yarrabilba

**21 May 2013-** Construction is underway on a state-of-the-art A\$5 million super park, the six hectare site which will be the heart of the new Yarrabilba community and a major recreation destination for Logan.

The super park will include a themed water-play wonderland, with water jets, streams and splash about facilities. Children will laugh, splash and enjoy falling water, squeezed through narrow gaps and rapids in stream beds. There will also be shallow water, boulders and an island with shade overhead.

Lend Lease Regional Development Manager, Rob Moore said Lend Lease was excited to be able to bring such an outstanding facility to the area.

“We see this new facility as a district park, with something for everyone. We’re determined to make it the most intensive play and recreational destination in Logan.”

Multiple play parks feature new and interesting equipment, especially designed to appeal to a wide range of ages from toddlers to teens. Park facilities will include a toddlers’ play area including a slide, tunnels, binoculars, steering wheel and play benches. Older kids will love the explorer dome and twin flying fox ride, and teenage recreation area. Old favourites like swings and slides will also feature, all over the latest safe surfaces.

“As much as Yarrabilba’s super park will provide something new and exciting it will also deliver all the tried and true park favourites,” he said.

Open spaces will be just as important, with a huge kick about area in the middle of the park, where kids of all ages can run and play, along with open areas for markets and other community events.

The extensive park area is well-linked via a series of walking and cycle paths that will meander through the site and across the naturally vegetated creek line, complete with distance markers for the fitness conscious. Numerous plant species are to be included across the site, including mature vegetation existing within the site.

Other aspects of Yarrabilba will be designed to deliver cafes and meeting places close to the park to complete the experience for park visitors.

The super park is expected to open to the public in stages, the first one completed in August. The full super park will be open to the public in time for summer.
