In September each year, Lendlease employees across Australia, United States, Asia and the UK work alongside their colleagues, community partners, family and suppliers to provide much-needed support.

Group Head of Sustainability at Lendlease, Geoff Dutailis said Community Day offers employees a chance to apply their skills where they are most needed and give back to the communities that support us.

“Since Community Day started in 1996, we’ve supported the community in a number of ways, ranging from aiding disaster recovery efforts, renovating buildings for those struggling with homelessness or domestic violence, restoring important green spaces and assisting children with special needs.”

Last year more than 4,000 Lendlease employees participated in Community Day across Lendlease’s regions in Australia and the United States during September, Europe in October and Asia in November, representing an estimated contribution of 39,688 volunteering hours.

Community Day, one of the Lendlease Foundation’s most popular programs, is complemented by Community 365, which enables employees to participate in skilled volunteering all year around. With Community 365, employees nominate a cause of their choosing and, through regular volunteering, can build their leadership, decision-making and problem solving skills.
