Singapore, 30 July 2019 – For the fifth consecutive year, Lendlease has been recognised for its commitment to providing a safe and healthy work environment at project sites and across shopping malls during the Workplace Safety and Health Council (WSH Council)'s annual Workplace Safety and Health (WSH) Awards 2019.

Lendlease Retail and Lendlease Singapore achieved the WSH Performance (Gold) and WSH Performance (Silver) award respectively, reaffirming Lendlease's core focus on fostering a culture of care and innovating to enhance safety performance. In addition, Lendlease's Amgen MSB Project also received the Safety and Health Award Recognition for Projects (SHARP).

“Health and safety remain our number one priority and we constantly strive to eliminate incidents and injuries across our sites,” said Ng Hsueh Ling, Lendlease's Managing Director, Singapore and Chief Investment Officer, Asia. “A culture of care guides our organisation at all levels and is embedded in the way we conduct business, ensuring everyone can go home safely to their loved ones, every day”

Apart from a robust risk management approach aimed at preventing the introduction and release of harm to workers, the organisation implements a progressive near-miss reporting regime and associated data analytics to promote greater accountability for safe outcomes, in support of WSH Council's Vision Zero.

For example, through the Lendlease Training Academy, Lendlease puts this culture of care for all into action by centralising safety



training required by workers and providing a structured framework to boost skills across the board.

Going above and beyond, Lendlease constantly looks towards utilising innovative technologies to deliver improved safety outcomes at its projects and assets. Through the adoption of technologies such as project site biometric access, Building Information Modelling (BIM) and drone site surveillance, Lendlease adopts a 360-degree approach to safety that aim to reduce risks faced during all phases of construction.
