

Nod to Barangaroo at Asia Pacific Leadership Awards

Sydney, 7 September 2018: The World Green Building Council has awarded Lendlease's Barangaroo South top honors in the Leadership in Sustainability Design and Performance in the commercial category, naming it co-winner alongside Aorangi House in New Zealand.

Barangaroo South has now won more than 50 local and international awards ranging from design excellence and product innovation to sustainability excellence.

Sustainability was fundamental to Barangaroo South's design – from raising the ground plane to accommodate predicted sea level rises through to installing over 50,000 LED lamps and 6000 sqm of rooftop solar panels. A shared basement with a recycled water treatment plant and district cooling plant to cool the buildings are further sustainability measures. Barangaroo South is also home to International House Sydney, Australia's first engineered timber commercial building.

The 2018 Asia Pacific Leadership in Green Building awards held in Singapore on September 6 recognised Lendlease's ambition to create a precinct that:

- Becomes Australia's first large scale carbon neutral precinct;
- Becomes water positive;
- Diverts 97 per cent of construction and 80 per cent of operational waste from landfill.
