## Street art gives a voice to domestic violence cause

**Sydney, 9 October 2017:** A new dramatic artwork with a strong human rights message has been revealed on George Street in Sydney today, showcasing a local survivor of domestic violence.

A collaboration between American Express, Two Good Co and Deliveroo and supported by Lendlease and Arup, the artwork represents Sydney's Felicity Cook, a survivor and advocate against domestic violence whose pixelated portrait has been assembled using 20,000 jar lids.

Created by local artist Noula Diamantopoulos, the 10-metre-tall mosaic located at the Circular Quay Tower site on 182 George Street aims to raise awareness of the campaign goal of providing 20,000 meals to women in need this month.

Project Director for Lendlease's Circular Quay Tower, Kimberley Jackson, said the artwork not only contributes to the character within the precinct, but more importantly takes a stance on violence against women.

"Lendlease is committed to investing in and creating better places where we can leave a positive legacy for workers, residents and visitors," she said.

"This project represents our commitment to delivering strong social and sustainability outcomes for our local community in Sydney, and allows us to pause and reflect in the lead up to International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women on November 25 next month."

Founder of Two Good, Rob Caslick said, "This collaboration with American Express and Deliveroo is an exciting next step for Two Good. Not only will it help us triple the amount of meals we're able to deliver to women in need each week, but it will also help us double the amount of staff we hire from shelters and refuges to create the meals."

The lids represent every meal that will be donated to nearby safe houses and soup kitchens.

Office workers in the precinct can support the cause by buying a Two Good lunch on the Deliveroo platform using their American Express card during October. For every lunch purchased, Two Good Co will donate a lunch to a domestic violence safe house, in addition to employing women from these safe houses.
