(New York, NY, October 19, 2017) - Lendlease, a leading international property group, is pleased to announce that its employees throughout the United States will be wearing purple in honor of Spirit Day, Thursday, October 19, to show solidarity with lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer (LGBTQ) youth and stand against bullying.

To foster solidarity and raise awareness Lendlease staff in New York, Nashville, Washington D.C. and Los Angeles will be handing out rainbow colored shoelaces and anti-bullying stickers to construction workers at Lendlease managed jobsites and having discussions around inclusion at Lendlease offices.

“At Lendlease our vision is to create the best places and to do that Lendlease must be a best place to work for all,” said Curt Harris, Assistant General Counsel and LGBTIA Employee Resource Group Chair at Lendlease.
