Lighthouse Construction Industry Charity

"In UK and Ireland, every working day 2 construction workers take their own life" a study commissioned by the Lighthouse Construction Industry Charity warns. The Lighthouse Construction Industry Charity is the only UK based charity that provides financial physical and mental wellbeing support to the construction workforce and their families. They achieve this by providing a 24/7 Construction Industry Helpline which is the gateway to access a portfolio of free and confidential support services.

The Lighthouse Construction Industry Charity and Lendlease have been working together for the last 8 years to promote and support positive mental health within the Construction Industry.





Hideout Youth Zone (Manchester)

Since 2020, Lendlease has become a founder patron of Manchester's HideOut Youth Zone.

The HideOut Youth Zone is a new youth charity based in Gorton, Manchester. HideOut opened in September 2020 and provides a safe place for thousands of young people aged 8 – 19 (or up to 25 for those with additional needs) to enjoy their leisure time. The youth centre is open whenever school is closed for young people, ensuring they have the opportunity to take part in many practical activities per night including sports, arts & crafts, media, music, dance, cooking, health & wellbeing and digital technology. Employability workshops are also available for those who need help getting into employment, education or training and our enterprise suite and business links inspire them to dream big and develop their entrepreneurial skills. HideOut exists to tackle inequalities and to create a level playing field where all young people regardless of their background and characteristics. It aims to support its young members to lead healthy, happy, safe, and successful lives.

Programma 2121

In September 2018 Lendlease Italy and the Italian Department of Justice came together to create an Innovation Laboratory for Justice at the Milan Innovation District development (MIND) to enhance the opportunities for employment and social inclusion of offenders present in Milan's prisons.

Non-violent offenders within the Milanese prison system have the opportunity to join the programme and gain the relevant skills to then enter the workforce immediately upon release to reduce the significant recidivism rate of Italian prisons. Through the promotion of training and job placements in our industry, Programma 2121 strives to enhance the sense of responsibility and debt payback by the beneficiaries towards society, train and provide professional skills to help former offenders develop a career; and reduce the risk of re-offending.

One of Programma 2121 trainees says: "I feel very lucky to have had this opportunity with Programma 2121. This has probably been one of the most significant experiences in my life, it has opened my eyes to many things I was not aware of. It has enriched me, very much".

Lendlease is committed to continue to support Programma 2121 and be integral part of its journey.





Key 4 Life

Key4Life is a crime prevention registered charity that works with young men in prison, those at risk of falling into criminal behaviour and those caught up in knife crime in at a National level In England. Since 2012, their mission has been to break the cycle of re-offending amongst young men aged 18-30 and to stop teenagers (13-17) from going down the wrong path. Key4Life's model is unique as it focuses first on unlocking the negative behaviour's that may lead a young man to re-offend, before instilling new emotional resilience tools and techniques, and thereafter building the crucial employability. Our work with the Ministry of Justice, in particular with the construction of HM Fosse Way Prison where Key4Life is now running rehabilitation programmes and support services available to its young offenders, has strengthened thanks to this partnership. Establishing a Lendlease shared value partnership enables Key4Life not only to maintain and expand its existing programmes, but to roll out new prison programmes in the UK.

LandAid

In the last year 161,000 young people were homeless or at risk of homelessness in the UK.

LandAid, the property industry charity, has one mission: "Together, we can end youth homelessness". They bring the property industry together to support charities delivering life-changing services for young people who are or have been homeless, or who are at risk of homelessness in the future. Their core grants fund mainly capital projects to renovate existing or create new safe, secure and affordable accommodation for young homeless people. Since 2022 Lendlease is incredibly proud to have become a strategic partner with LandAid, supporting their work to raise vital funds and awareness for their cause. Through this partnership, LandAid also connects Lendlease and our corporate volunteers to many local organisations within our communities for volunteering opportunities and matches their skills to the needs of charity partners around the country. Through our shared value partnership with LandAid, together we can invest funding and expertise to achieve lasting impact.





Woodland Trust

Woodland Trust is the UK's largest woodland conservation charity. Their vision is a world where woods and trees thrive for people and nature, delivered through their goals to protect, restore and create. Their mission is to maintain and expand the UK's urban forest (the trees in towns and cities) and to both protect and expand the network of trees outside woods. Their work is to increase UK woodland cover from its current 13% of land area to 19% by 2050 to tackle the biodiversity and climate crises.

The Legacy Youth Zone (Croydon)

Legacy Youth Zone is a charity located in the London Borough of Croydon set up in August 2019. It provides a safe, inclusive space for young people aged 8-19 and up to 25 with additional needs. They have over 9,000 registered members, with over 1,000 attendances every week, hosting a 4-court sports hall, gym, full-sized climbing wall, boxing studio, dance studio, arts studio, music room, multi-media suite, specialist inclusion rooms, and training kitchen. The aim of the partnership will be to enable thousands of young people to have access to essential youth work in their time of need. Lendlease's funding will fill a critical gap in providing accessible, stigma-free, multidisciplinary health & wellbeing support to young people who are vulnerable, at risk, or simply in need of some guidance.

UKHarvest

UKHarvest is a not-for-profit perishable food rescue operation and education charity. Their mission is to eliminate hunger and food waste by redistribution of quality excess food, providing education and engagement within the local community and inspiring innovation. They provide much-needed assistance to vulnerable people, by collecting surplus food from all types of food providers, delivering it directly to charities. Their purpose is to help nurture those most food insecure and combat social isolation, through education on reducing food waste and eating healthily. UKHarvest runs its own network of Community Food Hubs including the award winning Nourish Hub, Community Kitchen in London. The charity has worked with Lendlease back in 2017 on a one off food education session at Anchor House in London and we are incredibly proud of continuing this collaboration with U Harvest through our Shared Value Partnership scheme.
