Lendlease Americas Celebrates Community Day

(New York, NY, September 14, 2017) – Lendlease’s Community Day is an opportunity for the company’s employees around the globe to volunteer alongside their colleagues, community partners, and suppliers on projects that benefit the neighborhoods in which Lendlease operates.

One of Lendlease’s most popular programs among its employees, more than 5,000 people from around the world took part in more than 260 projects last year. Lendlease has helped support those struggling with homelessness, aided disaster recovery efforts, renovated buildings for those in need, restored important green spaces, and assisted children with special needs.

“We believe that it’s our responsibility to deliver environmental, social, and economic value wherever we operate,” said Denis Hickey, Chief Executive Officer, Americas. “Community Day’s purpose is for Lendlease to establish lasting partnerships with the local communities where we have a presence.”

In the Americas, more than 500 Lendlease employees participated in more than 40 projects that included building, gardening, cleaning, and painting facilities and organizations that benefit children, families, animals, and veterans. Some of Lendlease’s notable sponsored Community Day events are listed below:

New York – A team of Lendlease volunteers will be visiting Riverside Valley Community Garden, also known as Jenny’s Garden. The volunteers will help maintain the integrity of the park through planting drought-tolerant plant life, repairing fencing, installing soil erosion barriers, and raking leaves.

Chicago – Lendlease and Related Midwest will host its 14th Annual Golf Outing on September 14th. This year, proceeds raised will be donated to SOS Children’s Villages Illinois, Saturday Place, and The Children’s Heart Foundation. The event included participants from the real estate and construction industries.

Washington, DC – Volunteers will spend the day volunteering with the DC Housing Authority (DCHA) at Benning Terrace. Lendlease volunteers will create outdoor playground games, install new exercise equipment, create a walking path, update the community garden, perform general landscaping, and add picnic benches, art stations, and new site signage.

San Francisco – Lendlease volunteers will spend the day at the Marin Food Bank, where they will distribute food to members of the local community. Last year, Marin Food Bank offered community participants more than 50 unique types of fruits and vegetables. They will distribute more than 3.7 million pounds of potatoes and 2.8 million pounds of oranges, along with millions of pounds of apples, pears, pomegranates, tomatoes, and squash.

Los Angeles – Lendlease staff volunteered at Farm Sanctuary Shelter on September 11th. Farm Sanctuary Shelter founded in 1986 to combat the abuses of factory farming and encourage a new awareness of farm animals. Today, Farm Sanctuary is the nation's largest and most effective farm animal rescue and protection organization. The volunteers spent the day painting and fixing fencing around the sanctuary.

Boston – For the third year in the row, Lendlease volunteers will visit the East Boston Salesian Boys & Girls Club. Volunteers spent the day installing new sections of turf for the club's athletic field. The Salesian Boys & Girls Club has been operating in East Boston since 1945. Its after-school program is a home to hundreds of children in the East Boston neighborhood.

Nashville – Lendlease volunteers will spend the day at UNA Youth Sports Park. The facility has been the home of the UNA Bears since the 1960s and provides the opportunity for young people to participate in football, baseball, and cheerleading. Volunteers will be completing landscape and repair projects around the park.

Hawaii – Lendlease will participate in a clothing drive and give away school backpacks to children in need at Waikiki Youth Outreach. The organization serves as a safe haven for homeless youths, offering medical care, social services, and non-judgmental support.
