

Yarrabilba to flourish with new public art

Brisbane, 31 May 2016: Lendlease has launched a public art program that will highlight and strengthen the diverse culture of Queensland's most successful community, Yarrabilba and the greater Logan region.

The program, curated by Creativemove will be overseen by a diverse and experienced panel of key representatives from Lendlease, Logan City Council, community members and the local Yugambeh people, and will include a total of nine artworks across precincts one and two.

General Manager for Communities in Queensland, Guy Gibson said the program reinforces Lendlease's aim of creating the best places.

"Yarrabilba's public art focusses on the notion of flourish which responds to the site ensuring many vibrant places."

Jodie Cox, Director, CREATIVEMOVE said this was an unprecedented opportunity to implement such a diverse range of exciting artworks across a whole community planning framework.

"These commissions, with the help of Lendlease's Art Advisory Panel, will benefit local artists and create a public art collection for the community to enjoy and appreciate over a long period of time".

Stage one of the program, which is already underway, will see the first two artworks installed later this year at Darlington Parklands and at the new Sales & Information centre.

"Over the next 30 years, Yarrabilba public art will reflect, explore and elevate the aspirations of residents, enabling us to create the best places and build a place of belonging," said Mr Gibson.

Currently home to almost 3,000 residents, Yarrabilba offers a builder's display village, a \$5million Darlington Parklands, featuring a water playground and pop-up café, Shaw Street Oval playing fields, Bambini Childcare Centre and a 24/7 Caltex Service Station and Star Mart.

Further commercial and community infrastructure and amenity is imminent including an IGA-anchored convenience centre, planned to open later this year, a medical centre, tavern, and the first Catholic primary school, St Clare's, which is due to open next year.
